








- Support for 5 pilot projects (4 years) for establishment of Platforms of CoVE
- Address both sectoral and societal challenges
- At least 4 Erasmus+ programme countries (at least 2 EU MS), at least 8 full partners, with at least 1 company or industry representative, and 1 VET provider in each country
- CH eligible to participate as 'associate partners', i.e. on top of 'full partners'
- Must include EQF levels 3, 4 or 5
- Activities in (1) teaching & learning, (2) cooperation & partnerships,
   (3) governance & funding
- Maximum EU grant €4,000,000 / project
- Deadline for applications: 20 February 2020
