

Information about the hosting organization

Description of the organisation

The volunteering project at Permaculturepark Steyerberg/PaLS aims to activate young adults from all over Europe for permaculture, sustainable food production in agriculture and nature conservation. The principles of PaLS are based on sociocratic values that have formed the largest ecovillage in Germany: Lebensgarten Steyerberg. This community focuses on sustainable living and health concepts, permaculture, community building and antidiscrimination. Thus the European Voluntary Service EVS offers young adults an opportunity for exchanging intercultural experiences, gain new green skills and practice-oriented knowledge in bio-dynamic agriculture.

The Permaculture Park in Steyerberg is the oldest permaculture project in Germany. In the late 1980s the Lebensgarten community and their permaculture garden was founded by Declan Kennedy, former Director of the Permaculture Institute of Europe. He brought his expertise to the research and demonstration project in Steyerberg to develop modern ecological cultivation techniques as well as sustainable energy production. Today Steyerberg has become the smallest municipality in Germany to be included in the national Climate Protection Plan 2050 and to be awarded the title of sustainable municipality.

- **German language course included** starting with the beginning of the service
- two **EVS seminars** for preparation and evaluation of the learning progress
- professional **supervision** and **guidance** by educators and gardeners
- support of **individual learning goals** with the project leader
