

Erasmus Hundus – Erasmus+ Key Action 2











- Integrated transnational Master programme
- Open to all disciplines
- Delivered by an international consortium of higher education institutions from different countries worldwide
- Offering scholarships to students from all over the world
- At least 4 editions, lasting 1-2 academic years








- Joint integrated curriculum with common implementation (joint promotion, joint selection etc)
- Delivered by at least 3 higher education institutions
 from 3 different countries, among them at least 2
 Erasmus+ countries
- Compulsory mobility for all students: 2 study periods in
 2 different countries, minimum duration is 1 semester
- Leading to a joint degree or multiple degrees






Swiss institutions are eligible for Erasmus+ funding





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- Institutional costs: € 750 per enrolled student per month (max. € 1.8 mio)
- Student scholarships: € 1'400 per student per month (max. € 33'600 per student, not more than € 2 mio total per project)
- Individual needs contributions (max. € 120'000 per project)







- Support the development and design of new Erasmus Mundus programmes by facilitating the setup or new partnerships
- This should involve under-represented countries or HEIs
- Outcome: basic joint mechanisms agreed and ready
- Mono-beneficiary

- €55,000 lump sum for 15 months

- EMA: submission possible every year (deadline mid-February)
- Pilot on joint European Degree Label ongoing (several Swiss HEI, SERI and AAQ involved)
