

International Pilot Programme 2018-2020

FUNDING AREAS

INTENSIVE PROGRAMME	SHORT COURSES for subject-related work; Summer / Winter
	schools (recommended: min. 10, max. 60 days)
	Implementation within max. 1 year
OPEN PROJECT FUND	i.e. joint modules with / without mobility component, new curricula, MOOCs and training modules
	Implementation within max. 2 years

International Pilot Programme 2018-2020

WHO CAN APPLY

Professors, researchers, staff working at a Swiss university Experts of a business enterprise or organisation;

Applications are eligible if submitted by entities which do have legal personality. Ideally a consortium of at least 2 institutions from 2 different countries (1 x Switzerland and 1 x non-European country).

CALL 2019 – ELIGIBLE COSTS: MAXIMUM 60% OF TOTAL

Project management	coordination and implementation
Mobility	travel and subsistence
Extra costs	dissemination, external experts, etc.
Cost ceiling	max. 50'000 CHF per year
Self-Financing	min. 40% of total costs

project can not be subsidized also with Erasmus+ funding
